This session at Kinsmen Sports Centre, we are offering a 12 week long program starting on Saturday, September 20th.

As some classes are offered at multiple start times we will combine times if enrollment is low.

PROGRAM COSTS:

At Kinsmen all fall classes are being offered for 12 weeks of 1.5 hour lessons at a cost of \$375*.

*There is also an additional \$35 yearly insurance and registration fee paid to Diving Canada/Alberta Diving (valid Sept 1, 2025-Aug 31, 2026).

FAMILY AND MULTIPLE DAYS OPTION: Full fees are charged for the first diver and 10% discount on class fees will be given to each additional family member. This discount also applies to the same child attending more than one day per week.

FREE CLASSES! These classes can be cash free to those who want to volunteer at our bingos!

Each lesson consists of a session of strengthening, stretching and physical conditioning, a session on trampolines with high repetitions of skills possible, then onto the dryland diving boards (at KSC) with landing mats for another session of high repetition springboard skills. After this, the divers have an additional period in the water using diving boards ranging from 1/4 meter, 1/2 meter, 1 meter and 3 meter learning to perfect their acrobatic diving skills. Report cards and badges will be issued following the session. You may also participate in recreational diving meets held throughout the season.

Because our club also relies on bingo revenues to help keep the cost of the program affordable to everyone, we are looking for families to volunteer at bingos which will help subsidize your Learn to Dive fees. If you are interested in signing up for bingos please contact the office for more information. Bingo credits are \$70 for an afternoon or evening and \$105 for late night.
