Divers return from Montreal's Age Group & Senior Nationals

Edmonton Springboard & Platform Diving Club sent **19 divers and 4 coaches** to the 2007 Montreal Junior and Senior National Championships. It was an exciting event held at the Jean Drapeau Parc aquatic facility. It was the first time for our divers to compete outdoors and the weather did play a factor in the competition. Again our club finished **3rd overall** in the standings behind Boardworks and the dominant CAMO club. For everyone it was an interesting and challenging meet with great diving for the five days of competition. Our top result was from Michelle Piper-Kulak who won the Girls D 3 metre event and also received a bronze medal on the platform. In doing so she was named to the Junior National Team and will compete at the Junior Pan American Games later this fall. Angelina Kroupko competed for the first time as a Canadian citizen and won two silver medals in Girls B on the 3 metre and platform events, as well she achieved the senior traveling standard in the Women's 3 metre preliminary event with 271.65 points and finishing in 2nd place in the prelims. In fact **Rueben Ross and Herb Flewwelling** stayed in Montreal to train for the Pan American Games held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from July 25 - 28, 2007. Reuben would have competed in three events but suffered a shoulder injury prior to leaving for Montreal. Instead he competed in the Men's 3 metre event and finished 13th while still suffering from his injury, as well as in the Men's Synchro Platform event with partner Riley McCormick. This is only their second competition together and they managed a 5th place with a score of 401.73 points, their best result to date.
